About Laurel Mountain Search and Rescue

So, you are interested in joining our team. Before completing an application it is necessary that you know a little bit about us. Laurel Mountain Search and Rescue is a non-profit organization that is currently training K-9 teams and individuals to help in the search and rescue field.

The Laurel Mountain K9 Search and Rescue Team looks forward to gaining new members who are dedicated to making our team professional and trustworthy for those companies or departments that call us for assistance. We certify and train to the highest of standards to ensure our team is respected and viewed as an asset for the area.

Our training schedule is intense and regular. We train every Sunday beginning at 1000 and train for 5-6 hours minimum. We also OFTEN train Wednesday evenings beginning at 1730, for 2-3 hours. We train regardless of weather conditions providing the conditions are not hazardous or dangerous to our team members.

We have various other events such as mandatory classroom training and certification testing, business meetings, fundraisers and deployments. **We require a minimum attendance (Quarterly) at training, fundraising events, business meetings and deployments.**

Our team consists of two primary positions, listed below:

Ground Personnel – There is always a high need for personnel that are not handling a K9. These individuals are the backbone of the search team. Ground personnel provide assistance with searches that may or may not involve a K9. They learn and provide hasty search and

grid search techniques to assist local LAW/FIRE/EMS personnel. This person often serves as a support person for the K9 team. They work closely with the handler, following the K9 team, alerting the handler to any terrain safety issues that may injure the dog or handler, assisting with navigation or communication and alerting on or documenting clues.

Search Dog and Handler-This is a team of the K9 and the handler. The K9 can be a Trailing, Air Scent or Human Remains Detection K9. The handler learns how to “read” their dog’s every move and determine where their search will take them. They focus only on the dog and their actions. It is not necessary to have a canine upon joining the team. Our team will help you determine what breed is best for the purpose should you decide you want to become a handler. We will work with a young dog and handler to achieve certification.

The positions above also include various other opportunities that are not listed such as, medical support and command personnel, along with others that can be discussed at training. We need and train for these positions using different courses available which will help prepare individuals for these positions. We also have fund raising events that will need to be staffed by our volunteers. As you can see there are a lot of opportunities to help our group become a service to our community and surrounding communities in case of a lost child or individual.

Our goal is to supply a search team with dedicated individuals with certified skills, to give the family every opportunity for a successful outcome.
